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UNIQUE ROLES IN IMPLEMENTATION



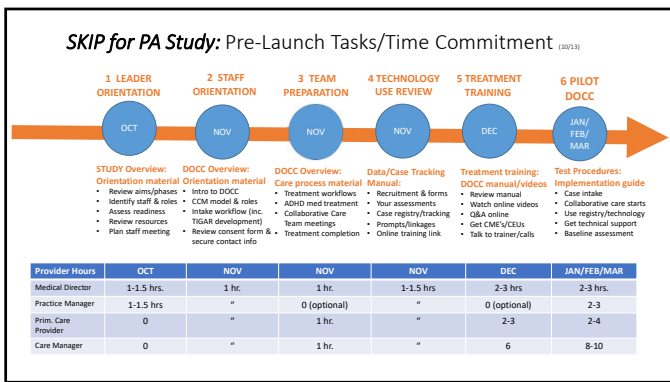

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SKIP for PA Study: All Phases and Timetable (10/13)

PHASE	TIME	TASKS
Pre-Launch: Orientation & Workflows	MONTHS 1-2: Virtual MTGS (3-4 hrs.)	Trainers prepare sites to use the DOCC model during videoconference calls: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Orient to study and understand the Collaborative Care Model • Review staff roles, tailor clinical workflows, and teach use of patient registry/tracking tool • Eligible staff complete online consent and standardized surveys
Online Skills Training	MONTH 3: Watch videos (3-6 hrs.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Providers get on-demand access to DOCC remote training platform with modular treatment content (9 topics – e.g., parenting, MEDS) to help manage behavior problems and ADHD. • Trainers will conduct weekly follow-up calls to review content/questions
Pilot DOCC	MONTHS 4-6: 2 cases (2-10 hrs.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pilot DOCC treatment/workflows with 2 cases (with technical assistance) to get ready for study and tailor procedures to each site
Launch Trial: All deliver DOCC; Some also receive support calls	MONTHS 7-24: Support calls 1 hr./mo. for 18/24 sites (18 hrs.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each site delivers DOCC to 2 new families/month over 18-months after random assignment to 1 of 4 implementation support conditions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Ongoing technical assistance (no coaching or consultation) 2) Coaching/consultation to provider team with DOCC clinical trainer 3) Facilitation for practice leaders with DOCC child psychiatrist 4) Both Coaching + Facilitation • All sites receive technical assistance as they deliver DOCC services and most also participate in videoconferences with an expert facilitator (weekly → bi-monthly) for 1 hourly call/mo.
Sustainment:	MONTHS 25-30: 1 hr./mo. (4 hrs.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facilitators help care teams sustain DOCC program & practice staff/supports.

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DOCC ONLINE TREATMENT TRAINING: MATERIALS AND CURRICULUM

- Clinical guidelines – for use by PCP/ CM with CG/child
 - Manual – hard copy and online access
 - Handouts & worksheets
 - Assessment forms
- Training videos – Each topic (2-4, 15-min segments)
 - Screening, diagnosis, engagement, ADHD care management, self management, problem solving, positive parenting, communication
- Watch, then answer knowledge questions
- Trainer discussion calls
 - 1/month for Q&A; or use provider portal prn
- Ongoing technical assistance/support
- CMEs/CEUs
